Greeting

Each child is greeted at the front door by his/her teacher with a smile and a "Good Morning" and walks into his/her classroom.



Circle Time

Beginning of the day | After the school prayer and announcements, our day begins with the Pledge of Allegiance. As a whole group, we do calendar, sing songs, read a story, play a game and/or a fingerplay.



Table Time/Centers

Morning | Children do themed activities at the tables including an art project, play dough, math manipulatives or games, literacy games and activities, science exploration and puzzles.



Snack Time

Mid-morning | Child brings in snacks for the class to share. This allows us another opportunity to pray together.



Free Play

Mid-late morning | Children independently choose what games/toys to play with.



Music/Storytime

Late morning | Children participate in energetic & educational songs. Teacher reads an abundance of children's literature throughout the day.



Lunch & Recess

Mid-day | Teacher stays in the classroom during lunch. Children can bring lunch from home or order hot lunch. Weather permitting, the children and teachers go outside and get some physical activity.

Rest Time

Afternoon | About an hour's worth of rest is encouraged. Children do not have to fall asleep but they need to rest their mind and body.

Dismissal

Teachers walk children outside to their parents and/or the EDP ladies come to escort those students to EDP.
