In addition, there is a non-refundable Registration Fee of \$250.00 per family that is due at the time of enrollment for 2023-24.

“Fundraising” fee includes Family Fundraiser raffle tickets in the fall and VIP tickets in April that can be sold to others or used for chances to win monetary prizes. “Fees” include SchoolReach, Powerschool, FACTS, I-Ready family yearbook and Lunch and Recess Supervision. This year, it also includes copy paper, color paper, hand sanitizer, lysol wipes and spray. Educational Resources is student books, online subscriptions, and maintaining technology.

The total for tuition, books, fees, and fundraising is divided into equal payments that are made to FACTS Management Company. You may choose from payment plan options for 10 monthly payments, 12 monthly payments, or 2 payments. A Supporting Parishioner is one who participates in the life of the parish, regularly attends mass, and supports the parish with a suggested minimum contribution of \$20 per week.

An important part of the mission of Catholic Schools is to keep tuition as affordable as possible. The actual cost to educate each student is more than the tuition and fees paid, for parishioners and non-parishioners alike. In effect, it's as if every student receives a scholarship without even applying. This "tuition gap" is funded by the parish, from weekly contributions. In addition, improvements to our campus are made by these generous contributions to the Capital Campaign.
